- another way to say "touch" or push a button or a key is **press**
- when talking about computers people call an electronic, software or hardware problem a **fault**
- another way to say "switch on" or "start" a computer is **turn on**
- A different way to say "restart" a computer is to **Reboot**
- When you cannot move the cursor on the screen, the screen is **frozen**
- Another way to say that an application doesn't start is **does not load**
- The buttons on a keyboard that have letters or numbers on them are called **keys**
- when a computer or application fails or stops working it **crashes**
- when you install the software again you **reinstall it**
- a hole where a cable is connected to is called a **socket**
- A two-word verb that means to connect a **cable** to computer or to an electrical power supply is **plug in**
- a "Lead" or "wire" which connects a computer to a printer or a power supply is called a **cable**
- The name of the part of a computer where you save/store your applications and documents is the **hard drive**
- The name of the power supply for a laptop or a mobile phone is called a **Battery**
- The part of a laptop where you move the cursor on the screen with a finger is called **touch pad**

- 1 - **to click** => to select an item or function from a computer screen, etc. using a mouse or a touch pad eg: click and drag the file to move it.
- 2 - **to update** => to make improvements or changes to software, apps or electronic devices to enhance their features eg: the company regularly updates its social media profiles with fresh content.
- 3 - **to download** => to add data to a computer from the internet or another computer eg: the website allows the users to download free music.
- 4 - **to block** => to prevent someone from contacting or viewing one's activities on social media eg: he decided to block the spam account that kept sending him unwanted messages.
- 5 - **to upload** => to send an electronic file such as a document, image, etc from one digital device to another one, often by using the internet. eg: please upload your assignment to the online platform before the deadline.
- 6 - **to type** => to write using a physical or digital keyboard. eg: she typed the essay on her laptop.
- 7 - **to scroll** زفر => to move what is being displayed on a computer or smart phone screen up or down to see different parts of it. eg: he scrolled down the webpage to read the full article.
- 8 - **to hack** => to illegally access a computer system, or online accounts in order to find, use or change the information it contains. eg: Hacking a social media profile is a violation of privacy.
- 9 - **to message** => to send someone a brief text, image, etc. in an electronic form. eg: they messaged each other throughout the day to stay connected.

10) **to program** => to write a set of codes in order to make a computer or a machine perform a particular task. eg. they programmed the security system to send alerts in case of any intrusions.

11) - **to encrypt** ^{تشفير} => to convert data or information into a coded form, mainly to prevent ~~unauthorized~~ unauthorized access. eg. he encrypted his personal files on the computer to safeguard his privacy.

12) - **to tweet** ^{يُتَوَدَّ} => to post or send something on Twitter. eg. he tweets daily updates about his work projects to keep his followers informed.

13) - **to reboot** => to cause a computer system to load, especially immediately after it has been turned off. eg. she rebooted the router to reset the internet connection.

14) - **to plugin** => to connect something to an electrical port. eg. Don't forget to plugin your phone charger before you go to bed.

15) **to debug** ^{يُصَدِّق} => to detect and remove fault in a software. eg. the software developer spent hours debugging the program to identify and fix the errors.
