Word Formation

Mainly in the form of exercises, with a focus on working words such as of the language of Earth Sciences: origin of words (etymology)/ formation of words (root, radical)/ word family (prefix, suffix). and The silent letters at the end of words by learning to search for a word from the same family justifying the silent letter.

The meaning of words.

In the form of exercises, we will discuss: nature of words (nouns, verbs, adjectives, etc.) / meaning of words (proper, figurative, polysemy) / nuances of a word's meaning (synonymy) / similarities between words (homonyms, paronyms) / words with opposite meaning (antonyms).

- The style of the sentence:

In the form of exercises, the following will be covered: the elements of the sentence / the types of sentences / the sentence forms/ active, passive, pronominal voices / nominalization.

- Introduction to Bibliographic Research

- objective / notion of plagiarism

- understanding of the subject to be addressed (defining keywords, research areas, etc.)

- identification, localization, and search for documentation tools (library, files, databases of data, the different types of documents ...)

- use of information (bibliographic record, note-taking, summary, summary notes, photocopies, ...)

- Bibliographic references: writing rules for different types of documents

(monographs, chapter in document, journal articles, thesis (s), electronic document, ...)

Application: for a specific topic (without addressing the topic), the student will have to search for x (to be defined) references bibliographic.

The BU visit must be organized with the library managers. A presentation (by the staff of the B.U.) on the role of the various departments, will present to the student the path from the choice- the acquisition of a book on loan by the student, including its processing (material sheets and author, catalog, computerized database), its registration (the symbol), its storage (store) to his consultation (reading room) or his loan.

This visit will give rise to a note-taking exercise during the visit and the drafting of a visit report to give to the teacher.

- The architecture of a monograph
